- 4. A plan You must put legs on the vision and make it work.




- God gave **Noah** a specific plan to build the Ark.
- God gave **Moses** a specific pattern to build the Tabernacle.
- God gave **Joshua** a strategic plan to conquer the Promised Land.
- Nehemiah used strategy, effective leadership, and organization to rebuild Jerusalem.
- In **Exodus 18**, we observe Jethro teaching Moses the power of delegation and leadership structures.
- In **Daniel 6:1-2**, we observe how King Darius administered the Persian Empire with a shrewd sense of delegation and accountability.
- In Acts 6:1-6, we observe the early church establishing a structure of leadership to support future growth and sustainability.
- The plans of the diligent lead surely to plenty, but those of everyone who is hasty, surely to poverty.

AT VICTORY CHAPEL, WE HAVE BROKEN DOWN THE PROCESS OF PLANTING INTO 4 PHASES

- PHASE 1 Preparation
- PHASE 2 Pre-Launch
- **PHASE 3** Launch Day
- PHASE 4 Post Launch

Our objective is to establish a plan, clearly-defined goals, action steps, and a budget for each phase.

Rather than starting *early* and starting *small*, our objective is to launch *later* so that we can launch *large*r.

We PREPARED to plant over a year before we moved on site.

- Studied the demographics of San Marcos (<u>www.city-data.com</u>).
- We read a variety of church planting resources (articles, videos, books, podcasts, etc.).

- We consulted with new and experienced church planters.
- We prayed very specifically for certain things.

Our PRE-LAUNCH phase started in September and will end around Easter 2019

- A 6-month trial and building season (figuring out what works and what doesn't work)
- We have one church service a month (soft launch/preview service).
- The plan is to emphasize friendships, relationships, small groups, and one-on-one connections over formal church services.
- We are forming a list of community and guest contacts.
- We are reaching out to our ministry network to raise funds and monthly support.

Create a Culture of Excellence and Improvement

Establish Effective Guest-Relations Efforts and Follow-Up System

Establish Plans and Polices for Children's Ministry

January - April

Create an Environment Where the Lost are Saved


Start a Pipeline of Leadership Development




