THE INNOVATION CORRIDOR


The region between Austin and San Antonio is known by many as America's innovation corridor. This is due in large part to its expansive growth along Interstate 35. This corridor is expanding more rapidly than any other in the nation. The area is home to three of the 10 counties with more than 100,000 residents that have logged the fastest population growth in the country since 2010.

In fact, there is no regional economy that has more momentum than the one that straddles the 74 miles between Austin and San Antonio.

The region around I-35 is known as Hill Country and is home to some of the nicest land in the state of Texas, attracting a growing populace of wealthy boomers seeking rural retreats.

THE FACTS

- In San Marcos, the unchurched population (51.2%) exceeds that of all religious groups combined (44.5%).
- Over the last 10 years, the nonreligious/unchurched population has increased substantially more than all religious groups combined.
- The largest increase among religious groups is seen among the number of Catholic churches. The smallest increase among religious groups is seen among protestant churches.
- Half of all the people who live in San Marcos and the larger Hays County do not attend a church or classify themselves as religious. For every two people that live in the area, one does not have a relationship with Jesus Christ (or may not even believe in God). If the total population of San Marcos is 62,000, then we can gather that over 30,000 people over a land area of under 20 square miles do not believe in the Christian faith.





Overview map showing the requested trade area(s) around ehopkinsTX, 630 E Hopkins St, San Marcos, TX, 78666:





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




Population

The 2017A population estimate in this selected geography is68,662 . The 2010 Census revealed a population of 56,073 , and in 2000 it was 45,414 representing a 23.5% change. It is projected the population in this area will be 72,972 in 2022, representing a change of 6.3% from 2017A. The current population is 50.2% male and 49.8% female. In 2017A, the median age of the population in this area was 24.2 , compared to the Entire US median age which was 37.8 . The population density in your area is 874.9 people per square mile.

Households

There are currently25,316 estimated households in this selected geography. The Census revealed household counts of 20,321 in 2010 and 15,816 in 2000, representing a change of 28.5% . It is projected the number of households in this area will be27,726 in 2022, representing a change of 9.5% from the current year.

In 2010, the average number of years in residence in this geography's population is 9.0 . The average household size in this geography was 2.4 people and the average family size was 3.3 people. The average number of vehicles per household in this geography was 1.8 .

Income

In 2017A, the median household income in this selected geography was\$33,695, compared to the Entire US median which was \$56,286. The Census revealed median household incomes of \$31,521 in 2010. It is projected the median household income in this area will be \$39,440 in 2022, which would represent a change of 17.0% from the current year.

In 2017A, the per capita income in this area was\$17,702 , compared to the Entire US per capita, which was \$28,088 . The 2017A average household income for this area was \$19,234 , compared to the Entire US average which was \$30,982 .

Race & Ethnicity

In 2017A, the racial makeup of this selected area was as follows: 75.6% White; 5.6% Black; 0.9% Native American; 2.4% Asian/Pacific Islander; and15.5% Other. Compare these to the Entire US racial makeup which was: 70.4% White, 12.8% Black, 1.0% Native American, 5.7% Asian/Pacific Islander and 10.0% Other.

People of Hispanic ethnicity are counted independently of race. People of Hispanic origin make up43.3% of the current year population in this selected area. Compare this to the Entire US makeup of 17.9%. Changes in the population within each race and ethnicity category from the 2000 Census to the 2010 Census are as follows: 32.1% American Indian, Eskimo, Aleut Population; 78.5% Asian, Pacific Islander; 9.3% Black; 34.1% Hispanic Ethnicity; -12.8% Other; White 33.6%.

Housing

The median housing value in this area was\$83,667 in 2000; compare this to the Entire US median of \$110,813 for the same year. The estimated median housing value in 2017A in this area is \$159,279; compare this to the Entire US median of \$193,953 for the same year. In 2010 there were 95.8% owner occupied housing units in this area vs. 95.8% estimated in 2017A. Also in 2010, there were 0.7% renter occupied housing units in this area vs. 0.7% estimated in 2017A. The average rent in 2017A was \$750 .




